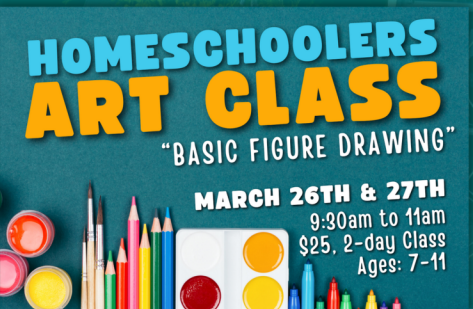

83RD & LEXINGTON CORRIDOR STUDY

Thank you to everyone who participated in the 83rd & Lexington Corridor Study, whether by attending the Open House in early February, taking the survey, and/or providing feedback on the interactive concepts map. We received valuable input and feedback from residents, which will greatly inform the next steps of the study.

Next Steps

The consultants are now compiling all the collected data, including crash records, historical information, corridor characteristics, and public input, to develop their draft recommendation. This draft will be presented to the City Council in the next couple of months. Following this presentation, a final report will be prepared.



83rd & Lexington Study Open House

These steps will position the City to begin exploring financing and funding options for the project, likely to be implemented in phases over future years. It's important to note that, at this time, no funding has been identified for the final design or construction of these potential improvements. K-10: 103RD STREET WIDENING UPDATE

The KDOT team has been doubling down – literally – on progress on the 103rd Street Widening Project, utilizing two paving crews working simultaneously to take advantage of the unseasonably warm February temperatures. In a single day, crews placed more than 1,800 cubic yards of concrete pavement along West 103rd Street, making major strides toward the project's completion date later this year.

In the coming months, crews will continue placing concrete paving on Astra Parkway, Lexington Avenue, and West 103rd Street east of Astra Parkway; additionally, subgrade stabilization, base rock, and paving operations on West 103rd Street west of Astra Parkway, including the Edgerton Road roundabout, will begin this spring.
