CHANGES TO UTILITY BILLING CYCLE

Good news for our utility account holders: we're updating our billing cycle, so you'll now have more turnaround time between receiving your bill and the actual due date! These changes go into effect this month.

We were able to shorten the necessary meter reading period by upgrading meter technology and extend the due date to the 15th by removing the confusing grace period.

**People set up on ACH (bank account) auto pay will still have their payments drafted on the 10th of each month.*

LARGE-ITEM PICK UP REFRESHER

As we approach the next round of bulk item pickups, here's a quick refresher on this handy monthly service:

- **When:** Your bulk pickup day is your first trash service day of the month
- **What:** This service is for items that don't fit in your trash can, not for extra trash bags
- **Number of Items:** You can set out a maximum of 4 items
- **Accepted Items:** Furniture, appliances (without refrigerant), and bicycles
- **Not Accepted:** Extra trash bags (unless they have a bag tag), appliances containing refrigerant, remodeling materials, and tires
