83RD & LEXINGTON CORRIDOR STUDY UPDATE

The 83rd & Lexington Corridor Study consultant team delivered their final recommended plan to the City Council early November, offering a vision for De Soto's infrastructure and future development.



83rd & Lexington Corridor Final Plan

This comprehensive plan lays out improvements designed to enhance connectivity, accessibility, and the overall quality of life for our community. **Here's a look at the plan's highlights:**

- **Smoother, Safer Streets:** Roundabouts at key intersections, designed to reduce congestion and make daily drives easier and safer for everyone.
- Biking & Walking, Made Easy: Buffered bike lanes and longer sidewalks mean more room for everyone to get around comfortably whether on two wheels or two feet!
- A Welcoming Community Connection: Thoughtfully planned landscaping and improved access points that create a corridor that supports growth and connects neighborhoods.

This plan lays the groundwork for De Soto to secure funding for these vital improvements, ensuring our community grows sustainably and accessibly!
