


TRUNK-OR-TREAT "TRUNKER" SIGN UP

103RD STREET WIDENING UPDATE

There's a lot of movement happening south of K-10, but since a majority of 103rd St is blocked off, here's a view from above!

KDOT is in the driver's seat on the 103rd St. improvement project, spanning from Evening Star Rd. to the Lexington Ave./K-10 interchange, and they're cruising smoothly along schedule (substantial completion by December 2024).

Grading and storm sewer operations are ongoing throughout the corridor, and in the coming months, they'll be shifting gears to focus on subgrade, base, paving, and bridge activities.
